
osConcert Bootstrap 4 Template Options 2020

In the newest osConcert V8.9 2020 we are able to construct full website templates like the 'One Page' templates we have at <https://bootstrapmade.com/bootstrap-4-templates/>

Let's take the example 'The Event'

We can install these template files into osConcert Templates and with a few adjustments we can use the HTML in our front page content file

(This file is the actual file that can be edited by TinyMCE Editor in the Admin>CMS>Homepage)

Goto the Admin>Shop Settings>Templates and install the **existing** template **'TheEvent'**

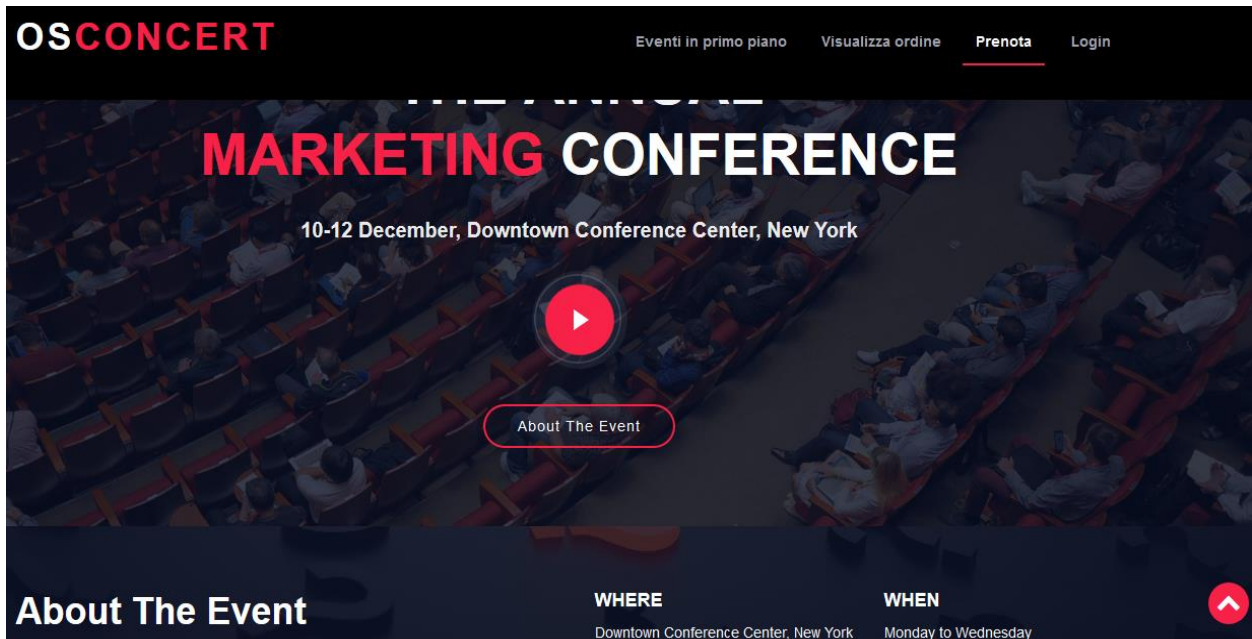

Edit>Set up with settings like this and SAVE :



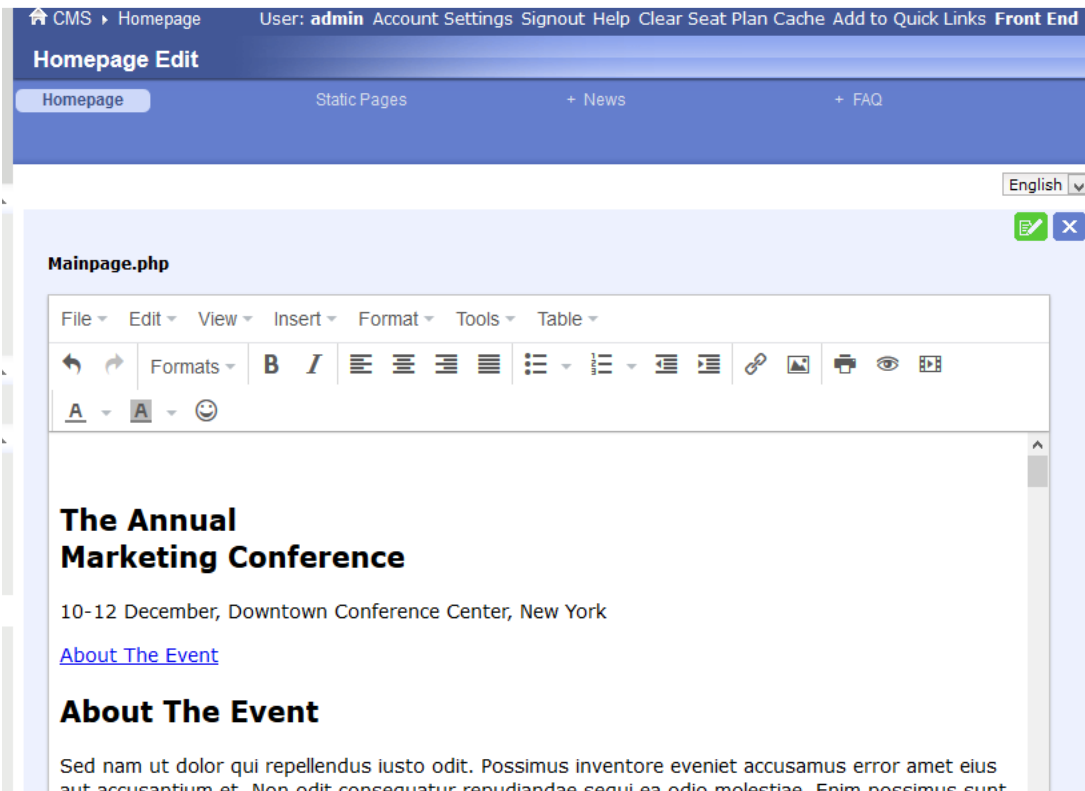
Now go to the Front End

You are now able to edit the TEXT and HTML and use the Bootstrap 4 features in your osConcert Ticketing application.

I think it's better to edit the HTML code directly in **templates/theEvent/content/english/mainpage.php**

Bootstrap 4 <section></section>

Not everything is automated. There are some other options to better separate the Bootstrap 4 features.

But you must know HTML.

In the Bootstrap 4 template you will see the code separated by <section></section> tags.
